2.0 OPENING PRAYER/COMMENCEMENT:

4.0 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 2nd BOARD MEETING:

The following issues were considered as matters arising from the minutes of the 2nd Board meeting.

A. THE YEAR 2025 ADAMAWA SABER'S ACTION PLAN:

The Adamawa SABER'S Action Plan was reviewed and it was shown that Action Areas or steps relating to land administration registration certification and automation has been implemented to certain extent. It was also shown that achievements in respect of Action- Area relating to tax process were made. However, the meeting observed that, low achievement was recorded in terms of ease of doing business and or promotion of investment as was provided under 2025 action plan.

B. The meeting resolved to put concerted efforts towards achieving the low identified areas in the year 2026 milestones.

DAY'S/NEW BUSINESS

5.0 THE YEAR 2026 ADAMAWA SABER'S ACTION PLAN:

The templates for the year 2026 Action Plan were presented by the focal person of SABER, Adamawa State Chapter in person of Dr. Abubakar Bello Song, and the meeting had extensively discussed and agreed as follows:

- A. Seven Enabling Reforms Areas were identified, namely:
 - i. Development of institution and procedural framework for land management and Administration.
 - ii. Development of Digital Enabled Land Administration process with a view of achieving land transfer title within 72 hours.
 - iii. Improved regulatory framework for Fiber Optic Infrastructure.
 - iv. Improved sustainable large – scale investment.
 - v. Establishment of designation of special courts for handling commercial and business dispute.
 - vi. Harmonizing the ease of State tax process.
 - vii. Transparency of fees and levies for inter-State and intra-state trade.
- B. Inputs were made and agreed in terms of:
 - i. How to achieve the Areas identified under paragraph 6 A above.
 - ii. Objective were set.
 - iii. Relevant Stakeholders that will carryout the project, from the Business – community and the MDAs were identified.
 - iv. Timelines were set/agreed, and
 - v. Budget for implementation of the identified areas were proposed and agreed by the attendees of the meeting.
- C. The meeting deliberated and selected a five man committee to impute the resolutions of the day’s meeting into the provided templates and submit to the Adamawa SABER office on Monday morning the 1st December, 2025.

The selected five members were: Barr. Ibrahim B. Mustapha, Fidelis Jonnah Omeh, Sadiq Sabir Manchi, Auwal Bashir and Abubakar Rufai.

The committee was called upon to coopt all relevant representatives of MDAs which include the following: Ministry of Land and Survey, ADGIS, Board of Internal Revenue etc.

6.0 CLOSING REMARKS BY THE CHAIRMAN

The Chairman, on behalf of the SABER's office and ADCCIMA, which is the hub of organized private sector in the State appreciated the contribution of all stakeholders that participated during the meeting, and prayed for the success of the SABER's project in Adamawa State.

7.0 ADJOURNMENT: Consequently, Jonathan Solomon moved a motion for the adjournment of the meeting and the motion was seconded by Auwal Sa'ad. The meeting was adjourned to future convenient date, which will be communicated to members at the appropriate time.
